

COMMUNITY CLINIC AND PRESCRIPTIONS

ISA Member,

2016 was a difficult year for the ISA's Insurance and Benefits Committee. In August 2016, we were notified by Community that due to an accounting error, they had not been charging the ISA for prescriptions since we began the program. Community agreed to absorb the cost through the end of the year, however, the cost to maintain the previous prescription program would nearly double in 2017 if no changes were made.

Community also informed us that Wellsprings pharmacy was in the process of being sold and there would be additional changes required to continue our pharmacy program as it was.

The sale happened much quicker than expected and, therefore, the ability to continue prescribing and delivering on some prescriptions was halted. This happened with no communication to the ISA. We are embarrassed by this and apologize to all that have been affected.

To assure the continuation of the clinic and prescription program, changes will be made to the program for 2017.

Effective immediately: the services offered at the ISA Clinic will be limited to those on the attached **List of Services Offered**. A more thorough explanation of the 2017 prescription policy is provided in the attached **Change in Medication Policy**. **Effective March 1st** Eligibility requirements for the ISA clinic are: You must hold a 2017 Standardbred (Owner, Driver, Trainer, Groom) License. ****Hoosier Park Employee Licenses will no longer be eligible****

To assist with the additional needs of members during this time, the clinic at Hoosier Park is now open on Tuesday's and Thursday's 8:30 – 4:30 through the beginning of the meet. A reminder: it is possible and encouraged to schedule appointments with the clinic to avoid wait time when arriving for services.
