



## 2017 College Assistance Requirements Fall Semester

### Requirements for submitting a College Assistance Application

- Ω Applicant / Parent / Grandparent or Guardian **must be a 2017 ISA Member and hold a 2017 IHRC Standardbred License or USTA membership.**
- Ω Applicant / Parent / Grandparent / or Guardian **must be an Indiana resident by April 30, 2017**
- Ω Applicant must be **working towards a 2-year associate's, a 4-year bachelor's degree, or a technical trade school and Applicant's course of study or career objectives must be directly related to horse-racing in Indiana. Examples of qualifying areas of study include, but are not limited to Equine health and/or science and/or nutrition, Equine chiropractic studies/equine massage, Equine law, Equine dentistry, Veterinary medicine, Veterinary technical, Judges/Stewards Accreditation School, Farrier School, and the University of Arizona Race Track Industry Program.**
- Ω Applicant **must be currently enrolled as either a part time or full time student**

The following items **must** be returned to the I.S.A. Office to be eligible for College Assistance

- \_\_\_\_\_ Completed ISA College Assistance Application
- \_\_\_\_\_ Copy of one of the following to verify Applicant / Parent / Grandparent or Guardian Indiana Residency: Indiana Driver's License, Indiana Voter's Registration or the first page of most recent Indiana State Tax Return
- \_\_\_\_\_ Copy of the Applicant/Parent/Grandparent or Guardian's IHRC License or USTA Membership
- \_\_\_\_\_ Proof of 2017 Fall Registration from College/University or Trade School
- \_\_\_\_\_ Verification of part time or full time student status
- \_\_\_\_\_ Letter of recommendation from a high school teacher or college professor
- \_\_\_\_\_ Typewritten one (1) page essay that answers the question: "What are your educational goals, and how do you plan to apply your education in the horse-racing industry in Indiana upon graduation?"
